

Farmville Board of Commissioners
Special Meeting
February 23, 2011

The Farmville Board of Commissioners met in special session on Wednesday, February 23, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. in the Farmville Town Hall Court Room with Mayor Robert L. Evans presiding. Present for the meeting were Commissioners John Baker, Jamin Dixon, John Moore, Jake Barrow and David Shackelford; Town Manager James Smith.

Mayor Evans called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Fire Chief Lee Keel presented the proposed FY 2011-2012 Farmville Fire Department budget. Chief Keel explained that the tax supported component of the budget totaled \$148,793.65. In addition, anticipated grant funds and matching funds from Pitt County increased the total budget to \$173,193.65. He indicated further, that 27.35% of the budget would be derived from Rural Fire District Funds and 72.65% of the budget from Town funds. The tax rate in both areas would be 3.65 cents per hundred.

Commissioner John Baker said that the taxable value and funds raised would break out pretty close to where fire and EMS calls originate.

Commissioner Shackelford made a motion to submit the budget to the Pitt County Commissioners. Commissioner Moore seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

The Rural Fire District Board approved the proposed Fire Department Budget and agreed to submit it to the County Commissioners.

On motion by Commissioner Shackelford and seconded by Commissioner Moore, the meeting was adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
