

Farmville Board of Commissioners
Special Meeting
April 18, 2011

The Farmville Board of Commissioners met in special session on Monday, April 18, 2011 at 8:30 p.m. in the Farmville Town Hall Court Room with Mayor Pro-tempore David Shackelford presiding. Present for the meeting were Commissioners John Baker, Jamin Dixon, John Moore and Jake Barrow; Town Manager James Smith and Town Clerk Amy Johnson.

Mayor Pro-tempore David Shackelford called the meeting to order at 8:30 p.m.

Town Manager Smith and Developmental Services Director Ellis discussed the rules and explained the cost factor for the cleanup of the storm debris.

On motion by Commissioner Dixon, the Board agreed for the Town to pickup all storm debris stacked in the right of way and authorized the \$37,500, which was originally set aside for Economic Development, to pay for the cleanup cost. If the cleanup cost exceeds the \$37,500, then the Board agreed to tap into the monies set aside for the Farmville Development Partnership contribution. The motion carried unanimously.

On motion by Commissioner Baker, the meeting was adjourned at 8:57 p.m.
