

Farmville Board of Commissioners
Special Meeting
August 23, 2011

The Farmville Board of Commissioners met in special session on Tuesday, August 23, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. in the Farmville Town Hall Court Room with Mayor Robert L. Evans presiding. Present for the meeting were Commissioners John Baker, Jamin Dixon, John Moore, David Shackelford and Jake Barrow; Town Manager James Smith and Town Clerk Amy Johnson.

Mayor Evans called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

1. Public Hearing- CDBG- Duck Rabbit Craft Brewery

Town Manager Smith stated the public hearing was to receive comment regarding the use of the Small Business Entrepreneurial Assistance Development Block Grant funds for the creation of at least three jobs at the Duck Rabbit Craft Brewery.

Mayor Evans declared the public hearing open at 6:02 p.m.

There being no further comments, Mayor Evans closed the hearing at 6:03 p.m.

2. Extension on Discounts Period for 2011 Tax Bills

Finance Director Amy Johnson requested approval to extend the 1% discount period on the 2011 tax bills from August 31st until September 12th due to the bills not being mailed out until August 10th when they are normally mailed out by August 1st.

On motion by Commissioner Moore, the Board approved the extension of the 1% discount period on the 2011 tax bills until September 12, 2011. The motion carried unanimously.

3. Approval for Chamber of Commerce to Host a Pig Cook Off Competition

Bert Smith, Chairman of the Chamber of Commerce, requested permission to use the Town ball fields in order to host a Pig Cook Off Competition scheduled for October 14th and 15th of 2011 for a fundraising event. He also requested permission to sell beer, for Police assistance to be provided and for electric and water needs to be provided by the Town.

Commissioner Dixon made a motion to approve the requests from the Chamber as requested to host their Pig Cook Off Competition fundraiser. The motion carried unanimously.

On motion by Commissioner Baker, the meeting was adjourned at 6:13 p.m.
